Invertebrate community assembly on high Arctic glacier forelands

Prof. Ian D. Hodkinson Liverpool John Moores University, UK



The seminar will explore the process of colonization of the forelands of High Arctic glaciers by living organisms. A contrast will be made between a typical land-based glacier, Midtre Lovenbreen, Svalbard and a series of adjacent islands, the Loven Islands released successively from beneath a large tidewater glacier. It will focus on the interplay between plants and invertebrate animals during the process of community assembly and explore the way in which different functional groups of organisms, particularly the invertebrates are an integral part of that process.
