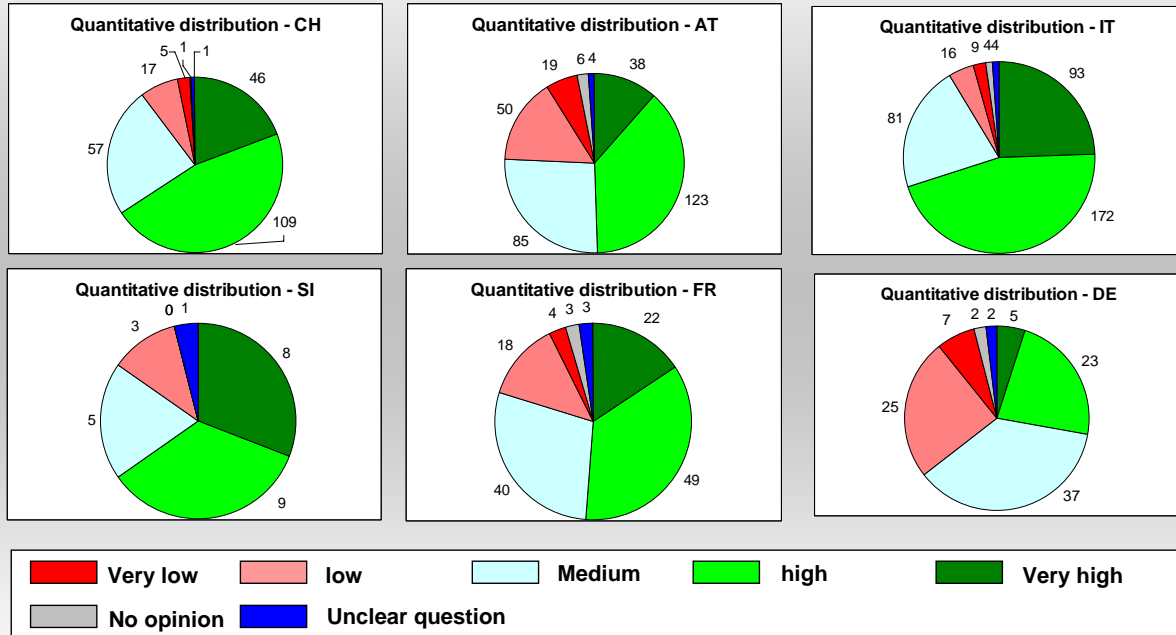

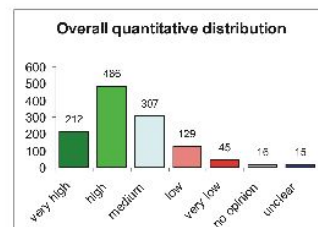
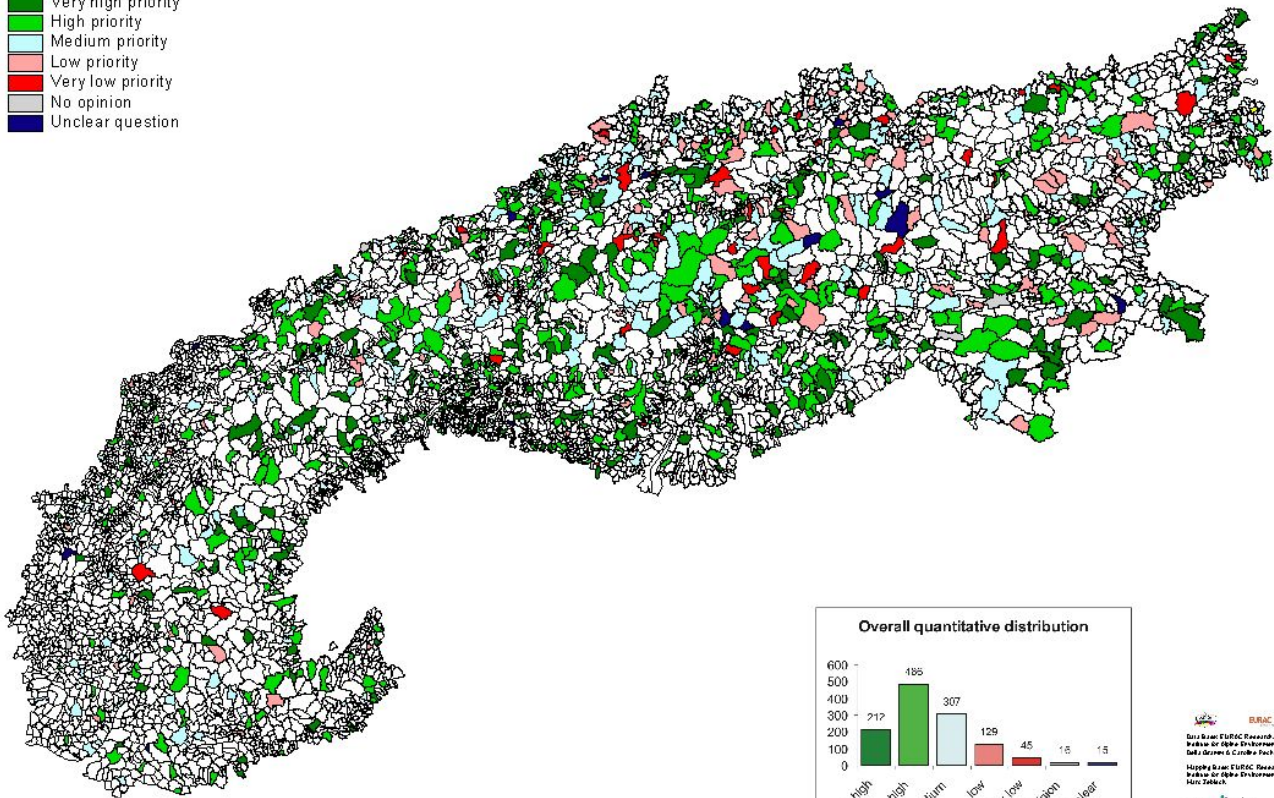
## Role of spatial planning instruments by nation:



## Spatial planning instruments:

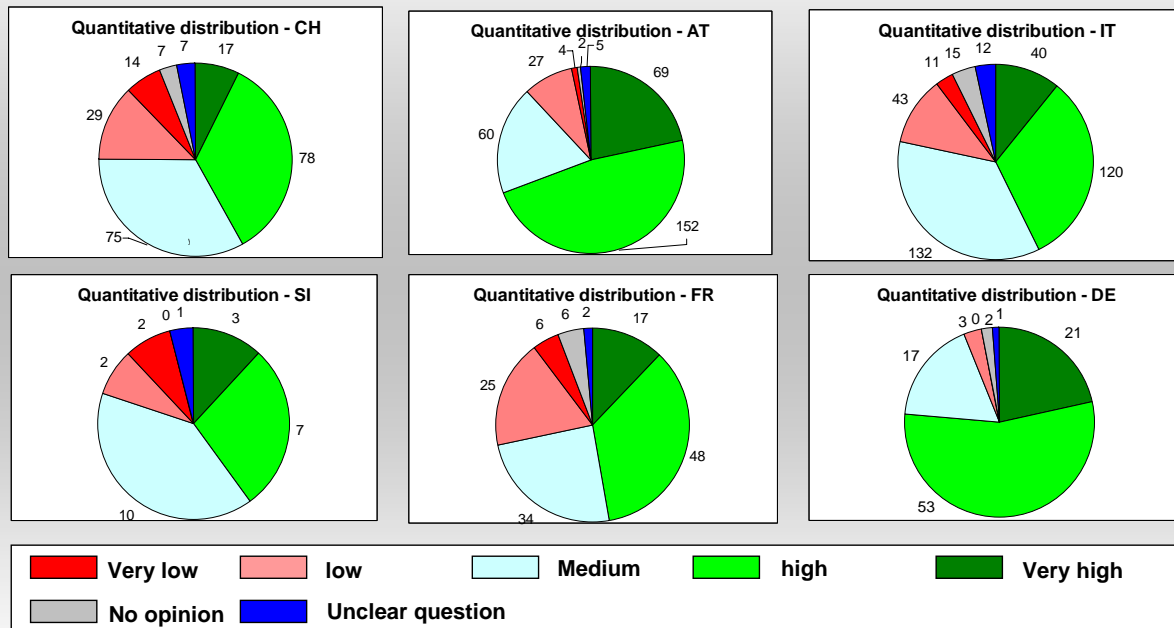
Higher ranked in IT, CH, SI and less accepted in AT and DE

## Role of existing taxes and subsidies by nation:

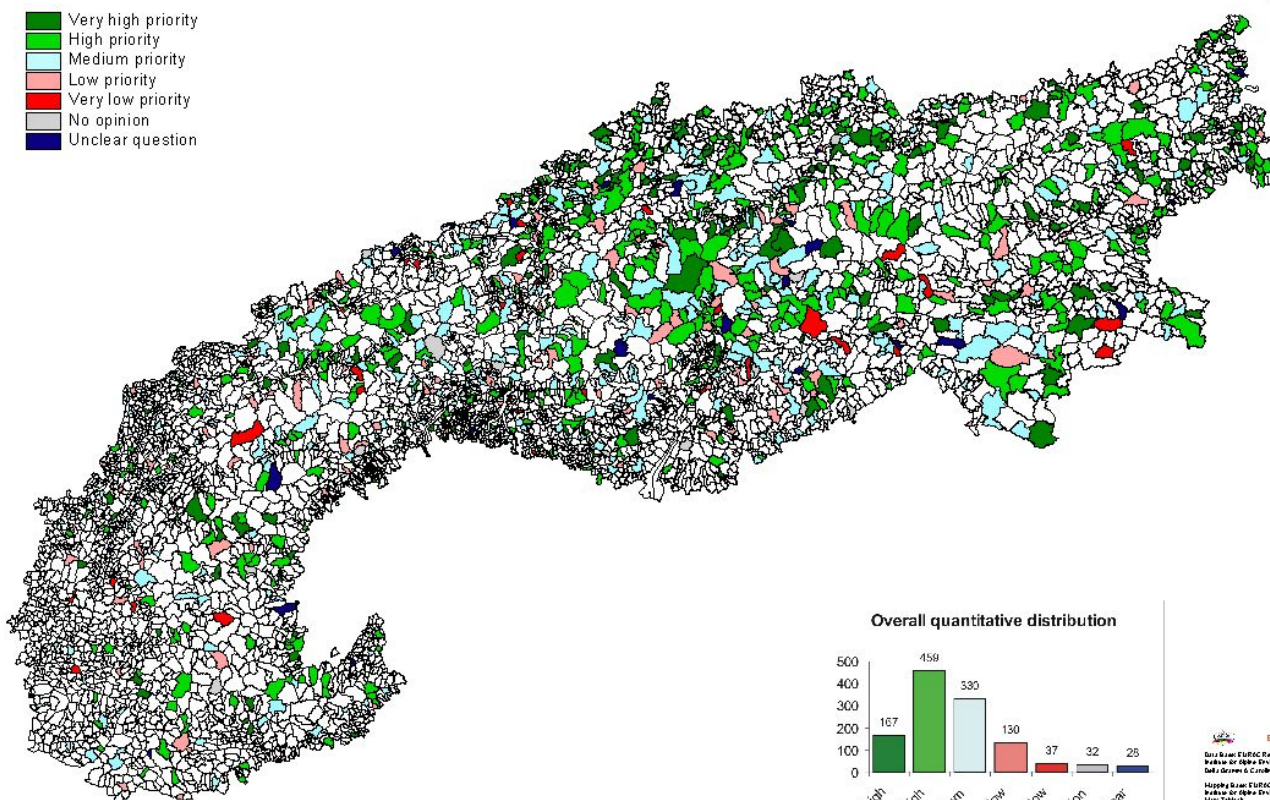


## Taxes and subsidies:

Local importance of existing taxes and subsidies as perceived by Alpine mayors

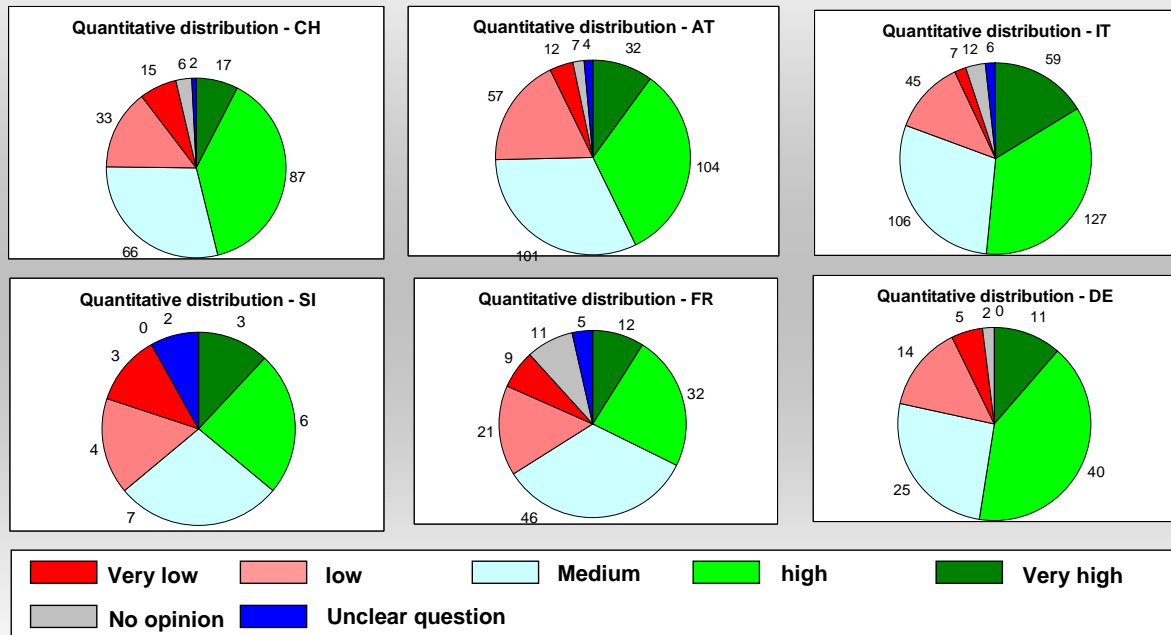

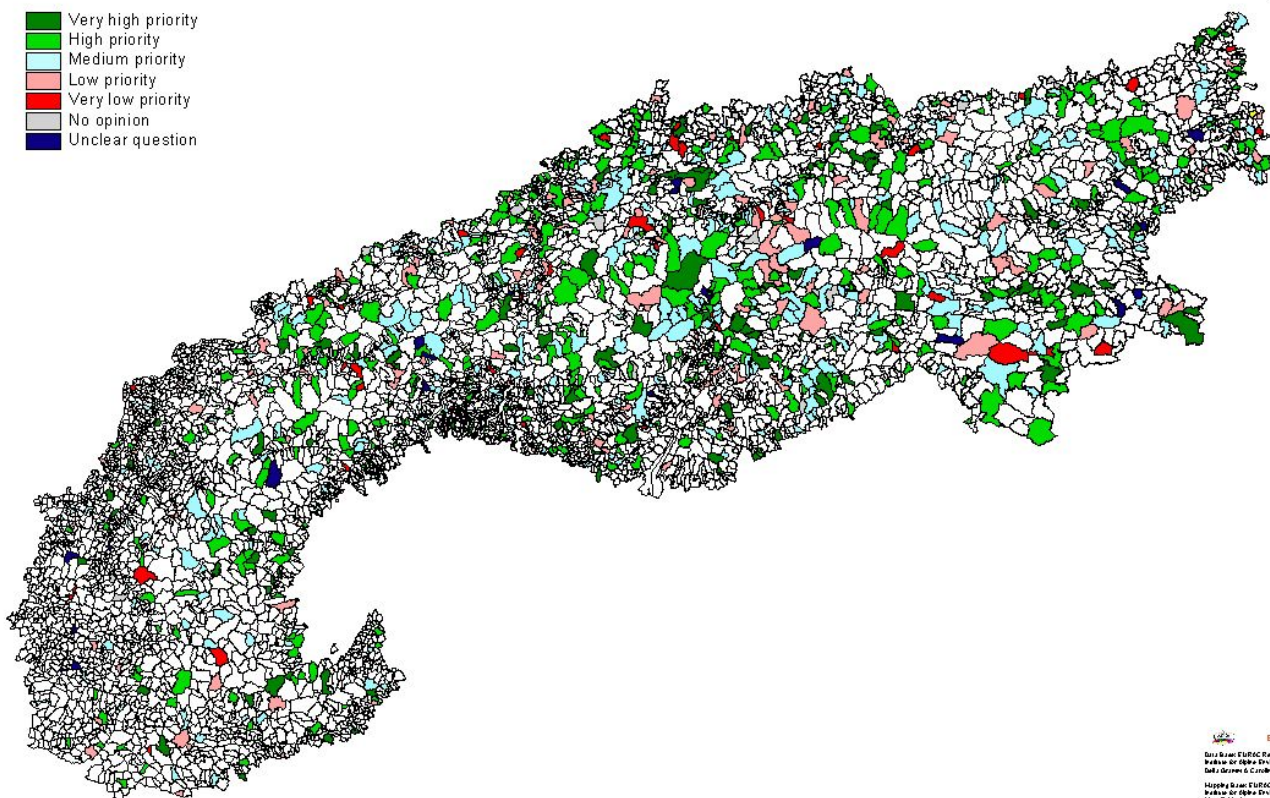
## Role of information, participation and marketing by nation:
