





Call for application for the participation to "Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program"

Rocks from Field to Lab: a practical course

at the University of Napoli Federico II directed to 2nd and 3rd year Bachelor degree students

The call for applications is hereby published for the participation to "Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP)" *Rocks from Field to Lab: a practical course.*

BIPs are short-term Intensive Study Programs, which include in-person and online attendance. *This program, in particular, will focus on the study of igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic rocks.*

The call, having deadline on 24 February 2023 is addressed to students from the University of Napoli Federico II (UNINA) and University of Innsbruck (UBIK) and University of Iceland (UIS) who, at the moment of application, are regularly enrolled *at 2nd and 3rd year of the following programmes A.Y.* 2022/2023:

- Bachelor Degree in Geological Sciences (UNINA)
- Bachelor of Earth Sciences (UIBK)
- Bachelor of Geology (UIS)

Online activity: 5 classes in March-May.

In-presence activities will take place during the first half of June 2023 in Southern Alps and in the Neapolitan volcanic district.

All the activities will be hold exclusively in English, thus knowledge of English language (B2) is required.

The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and physical mobility – both mandatory – and final paper) will receive 4 ECTS.

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Selection Committee will select 10 students per University. Applicants should be regularly enrolled for the a.y. 2022/23 to the 2nd and 3rd year.







3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following documents will have to be included:

- Curriculum Vitae, including documentation of the study progress;
- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words).

This will be followed by short on-line interviews to assess the English language proficiency between 27 February and 3rd March 2023.

CRITERIA FOR THE FORMULATION OF THE RANKING

The Commissions will assign the score as follows:

- Max. 40 points for the evaluation of the academic career;
- Max. 40 points for the motivational letter;
- Max. 20 points for English language knowledge.

In case of incomplete documentation, the application will be rejected.

5. AMOUNT OF THE FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

According to Erasmus+ Programme, the financial contribution is established as follows:

Students that will choose a "green" travel solution will receive another extra amount of 50€ one-time-only. Further information about the financial contribution will be provided to the students that will be selected for this programme. Students that will not complete all the steps will have to return the whole amount of the contribution.
