## Defending local & regional interests

CoR organises
consultations with local
and regional authorities;
CoR cooperates with
European Commission
on impact assessment
(CoR/EC cooperation
agreement)

European Commission

evaluates policy options

and prepares legislative

proposal

proposal and must consult the CoR

Pre-legislative phase

Within 8 weeks:
CoR cooperates with
national and regional
parliaments in order
to analyse compliance
with subsidiarity
principle ("early warning
mechanism")

**European Commission** 

adopts legislative

CoR cooperates with associations representing local and regional authorities as well as subsidiarity monitoring network partners to incorporate their views; CoR adopts opinion on legislative proposal

EU institutions start discussing legislative proposal. The EP and the Council are obliged to consult the CoR In cases where a legislative proposal is significantly altered by other EU institutions

CoR adopts revised opinion on legislative proposal

CoR initiates infringement proceedings at the Court of Justice if adopted EU legislation still does not comply with subsidiarity principle

European Parliament and Council adopt EU legislation CoR monitors implementation of EU legislation

Implementation of EU legislation:

- Roughly 70% implemented by regions and local authorities
- Regional parliaments with legislative powers also have to transpose EU directives themselves

## **Example: European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation**

#### What is it?

- <u>European entity with legal personality</u> for territorial cooperation across borders (third countries included) based on EU law
- Can be created by <u>public entities for all areas the entities are</u>
   <u>responsible for</u> (EU Member States cannot block the creation)
- May get <u>public and private funding</u> (EU, states, regions etc)









## **Example European Grouping in Territorial Cooperation**

#### How was it done?



- <u>1998:</u> CoR study
- 2000: CoR own-initiative opinion
- 2001: EC White Paper on Good Governance
- <u>2003:</u> CoR proposal on territorial cohesion taken up by European Convention (text which later becomes the Lisbon Treaty)
- <u>2003</u>: European Commission legislative proposal
- 2004: European Parliament endorses EC proposal
- <u>2006:</u> Council agrees (Austrian Council Presidency)
- Since 2006: 85 EGTCs, CoR EGTC platform
