

BizHub - Configuration on Mac OS X (10.9+)

1. Download and Install the driver from the Institute website (Service > Print)
2. Create a new Printer in the System Preferences' Printer Pane
3. (The symbol might not be there yet. In this case right-click the toolbar, choose „Customize toolbar...“ and drag it into the toolbar.) Select the „Advanced“-tab and enter the information shown below


Type JetDirect

Device Another Device (leave as is)

URL <socket://138.232.67.76> (first floor) or <socket://138.232.67.77> (third floor)

(once you entered the IP address, the other fields except „Name“ will be populated automatically)

Name BizHub (or anything else you want)
